



Competitive Food Policy

The United States Department of Agriculture has made the following regulations with regards to Child Nutrition Programs:

- No foods, other than those provided by the Child Nutrition Program Sponsor, may be sold during breakfast and lunch service times.
- No foods, other than those provided by the Child Nutrition Program Sponsor, are to be sold one half-hour before and one hour after breakfast and lunch service times.
- Vending machines cannot be placed in the lunchroom area at any time and are subject to the same time constraints as other food sales.
- Foods of minimum nutritional value are not to be sold at any time. This may include, but is not limited to, candy, gum and soda.
